 - o Each project should have a minimum value of 1 crore or above
- 4. Bank Solvency Certificates or Bank Statement (1X10=10 Points)
- 5. Relevant Work Experiences and Completion Certificates (5X2=10 Points)
 - o Certificates of relevant work experiences and completion
 - o Relevant work orders
- 6. Past Work Orders and Experience Certificates (5X2=10 Points)
 - o Documents of past and ongoing projects/work
 - o Professional certificates

Total Technical Score: 10X6=60 Points
