Technical Evaluation Criteria:

UCEP Bangladesh is undertaking a construction work of a semi pucca building at UCEP Mohsin Technical School Premises, Khulna located in Boyra, Khulna. The approximate floor area of the semi pucca building is 4800 sft.

Interested contractors are requested to submit the following documents for technical evaluation. UCEP Bangladesh will strictly evaluate all submitted documents according to the criteria and scoring outlined below:

1. **Company Profile (2.5x4=10 Points)**
 - Legal documents; updated Tax return, TIN, BIN etc
 - Completed project list; including project duration and value etc.
 - Manpower list; with designation, experiences and educational qualifications etc
 - Equipment lists with detailed specifications and purchase for year.
2. **Enlistment/Authorization Certificates (2X5=10 Points)**
 - Certificates from authorities such as LGED, PWD, PHE, EED, FS&CD, etc.
 - International authorities
3. **Completed Similar Projects in the Past 5 Years (2X5=10 Points)**
 - Documents of projects/work of similar nature completed in the past 5 years
 - Minimum two similar projects should have a minimum value of 1 crore or above.
4. **Bank Solvency Certificates and Bank Statement (2X5=10 Points)**
5. **Relevant Work Experiences and Completion Certificates (2X5=10 Points)**
 - Certificates of relevant work experiences and completion
 - Relevant work orders/agreements
6. **Past Work Orders and Experience Certificates of any type of civil works (2X5=10 Points)**
 - Documents (Work orders, agreements, experience certificates of civil construction work) of past and ongoing projects/work
 - Professional certificates of the organizations and employees

Total Technical Score: 10X6=60 Points

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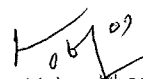
Submission Guidelines:

- Contractors must not change any items' description or specifications
- The quantity of any item can be changed.
